ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

Exchange is currently only available for Wellington Faculty of Health students studying in the Bachelor of Health degree programme. Bachelor of Health students need to complete at least half their 300-level major and degree requirements at Victoria University of Wellington to be eligible to graduate. Exchange is an option for any of the following Bachelor of Health majors:

- Health Informatics
- Health Promotion
- Health Psychology
- Population Health, Policy and Service Delivery.

You can go on an exchange in Trimester 2 only of your second year or Trimester 1 only of your third year.

INTERESTED IN EXCHANGE? HERE ARE YOUR NEXT STEPS:

1. ATTEND AN INFORMATION SESSION

Information sessions are held every Thursday during term time at 12.50 pm on Level 2 of the Easterfield Building, Kelburn Campus.

2. MEET WITH YOUR FACULTY STUDENT ADVISOR

Make sure you meet the eligibility requirements for Wellington Global Exchange and your degree/major. To check the requirements visit: www.wgtn.ac.nz/student-exchange/eligibility

3. RESEARCH POSSIBLE EXCHANGE UNIVERSITIES

When submitting your application you must select three universities and be prepared to go to any one of your choices, as availability is often limited.

4. PREPARE YOUR APPLICATION

To submit your application online, you need to prepare a preliminary study plan for each of your three university preferences as well as a budget.
