ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

You can go on an exchange at any time in your second or third year. If you go in your final trimester, you'll need to have completed the minimum core requirements prior to leaving and have done at least half your 300-level major, minor, and degree requirements at Victoria University of Wellington.

Maximum 1 x 300-level course per major can be credited back from your exchange towards your degree.

INTERESTED IN EXCHANGE? HERE ARE YOUR NEXT STEPS:

1. ATTEND AN INFORMATION SESSION

Information sessions are held every Thursday during term time at 12.50 pm on Level 2 of the Easterfield Building, Kelburn Campus.

2. MEET WITH YOUR FACULTY STUDENT ADVISOR

Make sure you meet the eligibility requirements for Wellington Global Exchange and your degree/major. To check the requirements visit: www.wgtn.ac.nz/student-exchange/eligibility

3. RESEARCH POSSIBLE EXCHANGE UNIVERSITIES

When submitting your application you must select three universities and be prepared to go to any one of your choices, as availability is often limited.

4. PREPARE YOUR APPLICATION

To submit your application online, you need to prepare a preliminary study plan for each of your three university preferences as well as a budget.
