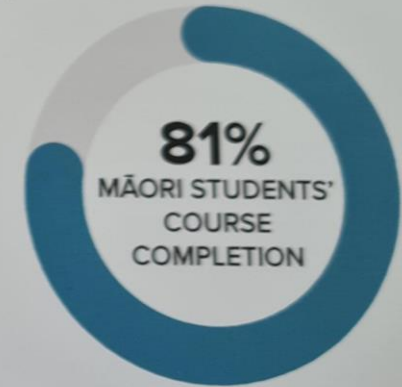

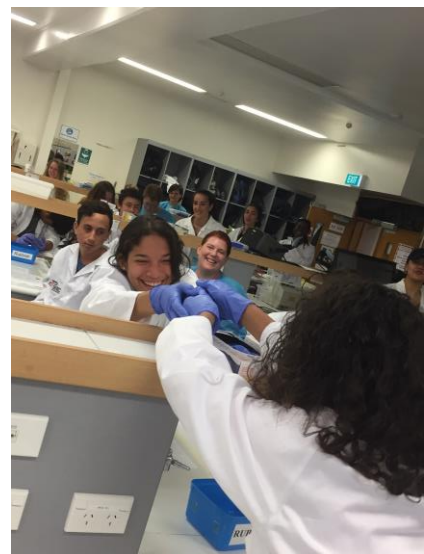
Matiu Somes Island
