## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

Bachelor of Commerce (BCom) students normally need to have completed the seven core BCom courses, especially FCOM 111, before going on an exchange. You may however apply prior to completing these requirements on the basis that you will have completed them before your exchange begins.

You can go on an exchange in your second or third year. Only one 300-level course per major can be credited back towards your BCom. It is best to aim to do unspecified credit on exchange (earning general points towards your degree) rather than major requirements.

### 1. ATTEND AN INFORMATION SESSION
