















27 million hectares NZ

80% of Maori land is underperforming or unutilised.







## Legislation - Decision Making



- Te Ture Whenua Maori Act 1993
  - Taonga tuku iho
  - Retain and promote utilisation

### Constraints by comparison with general land

- > Fragmentation is impeding the development of Māori land;
  - 27,137 Māori land titles, 2.3 million ownership interests in those titles
  - Almost half are deceased and many have land interests in multiple names
- Finance the lack of access to development finance
- Governance suitably capable governors that have general commercial and land development experience.
  - Average age of trustees
- Making decisions contacting people, quorum, thresholds,
